

Executive Committee Descriptions

President: The President serves as the chief executive officer and chief operating officer of the Society for a two-year term. This officer presides at all meetings of the Society and provides leadership and oversight for all Vice Presidents who report directly to the President. The President chairs the Council and is responsible for appointing all committee members and chairpersons in consultation with the Vice Presidents.

President-Elect: The President-Elect serves a two-year term before assuming the presidency and typically fills a Vice President position during this time (most often VP of Communications, unless serving as an Associate Editor for the journal). This role prepares the incoming leader to assume chief executive responsibilities and serves as backup to the President when needed.

Vice President of Organizational Health: The VP of Finance maintains the Society's financial accounts, prepares annual budgets and fiscal reports, and oversees all funds and financial operations. This officer works with management to ensure sound fiscal stewardship and leads the Finance/Investments and Fundraising/Sponsorship committees.

Vice President of Branding & Advocacy: The VP of Branding & Advocacy promotes SfRBM's reputation and visibility to the scientific community and public while advancing the interests of current and potential members. This officer oversees committees for publications, website, marketing/PR (both internal and external), and strategic alliances & outreach.

Vice President of Professional Development Excellence: The VP of Professional Development Excellence works to provide educational programs for both scientific and lay communities while catalyzing new research and promoting professional development. This officer oversees committees including the Free Radical School, Special Education Projects, Women in Science, and Young Investigators/Trainees.

Vice President of Redox Science Advancement: The VP of Redox Science Advancement creates an environment for the exchange of information and technology that promotes scientific excellence within SFRBM. This officer leads committees responsible for the scientific program, senior and junior awards, and fellowships.
